#### PROGRAM AND METHODS

IRO is a Master of Arts degree program of 120 ECTS credits. The language of instruction is English. Further elements of our program are:

- Duration: 2 years (4 semesters)
- Modules on IR Theories, Policy Issues, Global Flows, and practice-oriented skills like intercultural communication, conflict management and negotiation strategies
- I Individual study paths in either Global Politics or Area Studies
- Interactive study material, networking opportunities with experts and your peers in Berlin and flexible solutions for balancing your career and study

- Virtual and direct exchange programs with renowned universities in the United States and Europe
